

Minutes of the meeting held on December 19,2019 at 6pm in the Oceana Library

The meeting was called to order at 6:05 PM. Dawn welcomed everyone and introductions were made. Approval of the October and November meeting minutes was postponed.

Principal's report- April talked about the Harvest Fair that was held the previous Friday, when students could buy tokens to buy food and plants. The fair was almost completely sold out. Senior Movie Night was not too well attended. For the Senior exhibition deadline, more than half the students turned in their work a day ahead, they all seemed well prepared. Our school website has all the information about upcoming events and important dates.

Treasurer report- Elsa said there was approximately \$28,000 in the account.

Dawn Hope- talked about Moose Lodge as an option to hold the Parent Social, where OSPTO could reaffirm the values that we want to be able to move forward with-a solid foundation, to work hard, be transparent and get the community involved. She reiterated that OSPTO supports important events at Oceana like the Senior exhibition, Senior breakfast, staff appreciation and graduation.

Antonia suggested holding off the social until we can try to get the incoming freshmen families as well to participate, around February. Dawn said that maybe we could have two social events. April added that there are approximately 211 new families and typically some leave, and that these numbers keep changing until August.

Some ideas were discussed with regard to dates, maybe holding raffle ticket sales, prizes like succulents, hair treatment etc.

Dawn talked about mini grants and to get clarification on Ms Torres' request for a stipend. This was a request to pay the interim counselor who is an intern, as JUHSD will only pay her \$200. Antonia made the motion to approve this, and Dawn seconded it, and all voted in favor. Elsa will reach out to Ms. Torres to find out who the check should be made out to. Ms T is going to be out on maternity until early May. Elsa also mentioned that there are several companies that have a matching gifts program.

Dawn talked a little bit about the documentary "Like", which is especially significant in present times as the impact of social media is huge.

In other business, Mr. Menard spoke about a petition for Prop 13, which could be on the ballot. Meeting was adjourned at 6.55pm.
